The San Antonio AIDS Foundation envisions a community where people living with HIV will thrive free of stigma and discrimination and positive sexual health is a reality for all. Our mission is to eliminate new HIV infections, improve the health and well-being of people living with HIV, AIDS and sexually transmitted infections (STIs) through education, prevention, and equitable access to sexual healthcare. SAAF lead the way in supporting compassionate care for individuals affected by HIV/AIDS. Founded in 1986 as a volunteer-run hospice, SAAF provided residential nursing services overly 30 years to nearly 2,000 individuals living with HIV/AIDS. In the past decade, SAAF has evolved to address the changing needs of our community.

In addition to wrap-around support services for people living with HIV, SAAF now houses an out-patient clinic providing HIV, PrEP and STI services and an on-site pharmacy. SAAF's founder was the first to offer free condoms and HIV testing in the community. Building on that legacy, today SAAF provides over 5,000 HIV and STI tests yearly while reducing stigma through education and outreach and serving more than 2,500 people living with HIV.
