Dear Clients and Visitors to SAAF,

While the governor has removed COVID-19 safety protocols for many businesses, the current rate of new COVID-19 cases in San Antonio continues to be well above the threshold needed to relax precautions in a health care facility such as SAAF.

SAAF offices at 818 E. Grayson will continue to maintain COVID-19 protocols, including requiring mouth/nose coverings for all who enter the building. Food services will continue to provide 3 meals per day in take-away containers as the cafeteria will be closed to in-person dining. Case management and mental health services will continue via telemedicine.

HIV tests may be conducted curbside. Clients requiring tests for other STIs will be screened and brought indoors. All individuals must wear a face covering when indoors.

The Care Clinic has begun to see patients in-person, and will continue a combination of telemedicine and in-person services as needed.

We hope soon to have all of our clients and staff vaccinated against COVID-19, and for cases in our community to fall below the necessary threshold so we can again open our doors fully. SAAF thanks you all for your patience. We are so close to the finish line.
